Blended Visa Office-Referred (BVOR) Program
Refugees sponsored through the BVOR program are eligible for the following income support benefits from IRCC for six months:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic Needs Allowance • Shelter Allowance and Housing Supplement • Communication Allowance • Transportation Allowance • Maternity Food Allowance (if applicable) • Special Dietary Allowance (if applicable)
The costs for the remaining six months, including Start-Up Costs and additional special expenses as required, are provided by the sponsoring group.

Transportation Rates

Transportation allowance is provided to each adult, including seniors, as per the rate of public transit for adults and seniors in their community, or a minimum of \$82.97/month, whichever is greater. For rates, consult the links above.
Note: In communities where there is no public transit, a flat transportation rate of \$82.97/month is issued.
